## A legal disclaimer

We employ reliable and secure technology, along with other privacy protection programs, to safeguard personal information.

This policy outlines our data handling practices and how we collect and use the Personal Data you provide during your online and offline interactions with us. As used in this Privacy Policy, "Personal Data" means any information that can be used to individually identify a person, and may include, but is not limited to, name, email address, postal or other physical address, phone number, title, and other personally identifiable information. We may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you so that we may contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. Text messaging originator opt-in data and consent information will not be shared with any third parties, provided that the foregoing does not apply to sharing (1) with vendors, consultants and other service providers who need access to such information to carry out work on our behalf (and who will not use such information for their own purposes); (2) if we believe disclosure is required by any applicable law, rule, or regulation or to comply with law enforcement or legal process. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribe link or the instructions provided in any email we send.

SMS Opt-Out: If you are receiving text messages from us and wish to stop receiving them, simply respond with either "STOP" or "UNSUBSCRIBE" to the number from which you received the message. Once we receive your message, you will no longer receive further text messages from us.
